

Sex Education:

A Bibliography of Educational Materials for Children, Adolescents, and Their Families

This bibliography was prepared by the Committee on Adolescence of the American Academy of Pediatrics to assist health professionals in recommending educational materials on sexuality for children, adolescents, and their families. This bibliography includes material thought to be factually correct and suitable for the pediatric setting. Materials listed are limited to booklets, pamphlets, and fact sheets that are free or low cost.

Sex Education Bibliography

Each publication listing includes a brief synopsis of the content and the Committee's estimation of age and/or sex suitability. Developmental levels follow these approximations:

"preteen"	= late childhood (late elementary grades)
"young teen"	= early adolescence (middle/junior high school)
"midteen"	= middle adolescence (junior/senior high school)
"older teen"	= late adolescence (senior high school/college)
"adult"	= young adults, parents (college level)

Addresses for sources and other purchasing information are found at the end of the bibliography with sources listed alphabetically.

The Committee will maintain this bibliography in a fashion that is both current and in accord with the needs of the Academy's membership. We welcome comments about the bibliography and information on new educational materials that might be included in future editions.
